## INSTRUCTIONS

The SONS OF UNION VETERANS OF THE CIVIL WAR (SUVCW) is a patriotic and educational heritage organization. It was founded on November 12, 1881 and incorporated by Act of Congress on August 20, 1954. The SONS OF UNION VETERANS OF THE CIVIL WAR is the legal heir to and representative of the Grand Army of the Republic.

SUVCW National Regulations Chapter I, Article II, Section 1, requires the following: Each application for membership shall be recommended by a Brother of the Camp who shall vouch for the applicant's eligibility and moral character.

Application Type: A new applicant will check the Initial Membership Application box. A member desiring to record a supplemental ancestor will check the Supplemental Ancestor Application box.

The SUVCW membership application requires prospective members to choose one ancestor under whom to join the organization. Many members of the SUVCW have more than one ancestor whose military service would be qualifying for membership. Members desiring to record these other ancestors, both lineal and collateral, may fill out a supplemental ancestor application.

#### Part I - MEMBERSHIP

**ELIGIBILITY:** A **Member** (and Junior with lineage) is a male descendant, 14 years of age (6 to 14 for Juniors), who:

- (1) is directly descended from a Soldier, Sailor, Marine or member of the Revenue Cutter Service (or directly descended from a brother, sister, half-brother, or half-sister of such Soldier, etc.) who was regularly mustered and served honorably in, was honorably discharged from or died in the service of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps or Revenue Cutter Service of the United States of America or in such state regiments called to active service and was subject to the orders of United States general officers, between April 12, 1861 and April 9, 1865;
- (2) has never been convicted of any infamous or heinous crime and
- (3) has, or whose ancestor through whom membership is claimed, has never voluntarily borne arms against the government of the United States.

An **Associate** (and Junior Associate without lineage) is not required to have the above lineage but is subject to the second and third provisions of eligibility.

**Membership Request:** The applicant will leave this section blank. The Camp Junior Vice Commander (or Secretary) or appropriate Department or National officer will complete this this section. Visit the SUVCW website <a href="http://www.suvcw.org">http://www.suvcw.org</a> to find a listing of state organizations (Departments and local Camps).

**Membership Type:** The applicant will check the appropriate box for the type of membership desired per the eligibility requirements above. National Membership at Large is reserved for those who do not reside in areas covered by a Department, such as those residing or stationed overseas.

#### Part II - APPLICANT INFORMATION AND DECLARATION

The applicant will complete this section and will sign the form in the presence of a witness. The witness must also sign the form. If the applicant is under the age of 18 years, the witness MUST BE the applicant's parent or legal guardian.

The recommender will write his name. He must be a Brother (Member or Associate) of the SUVCW.

#### Part III - APPLICATION FEES AND DUES

**Application Fee:** The applicant will include with the application a check (U.S. funds) for the application fee and international mailing surcharge (if applicable), made payable to the SONS OF UNION VETERANS OF THE CIVIL WAR.

**Dues:** Prior to initiation into the SUVCW, the applicant will be required to be paid up on his annual dues. Annual dues are paid at the Camp, Department and National levels.

<u>Applicants joining through a Camp</u> will have the assistance of the Camp Secretary in determining the total dues amount to be presented as each Camp and Department determines its own dues requirement.

Applicants who send their membership application to the Junior Vice Commander-in-Chief are required to pay a \$10.00 Application fee, plus \$40.00 (if received between 1 January – 30 June) or \$20.00 (if received between 1 July and 31 December). If applying for membership from an international address, applicants should include an additional \$5.00 surcharge to cover international mailing expenses. Confirm the dues amount to be attached to the application with the Junior Vice Commander-in-Chief via email at <a href="mailto:JVCinC@suvcw.org">JVCinC@suvcw.org</a> prior to mailing the membership application.

**Supplemental Ancestor Application:** Members desiring to register their lineage from other Civil War Union ancestors will check the Supplemental Application box. They are required only to pay the National Application fee.

#### Part IV - ANCESTOR SERVICE AND LINEAGE

Applicants who are applying for Member or Junior membership (not Associate or Junior Associate) will complete this section.

Ancestor's Civil War Service: Information regarding the ancestor's Civil War service is available in his military or pension records, obtainable from a variety of sources including, state archived Adjutant General Reports (if he served in a state regiment of volunteers) and from the National Archives and Records Administration, 700 Pennsylvania Ave. NW, Washington, DC 20408-0001. Separate order forms (with instructions and fee information for copies of military or pension records) must be obtained from the National Archives and then submitted back to them.

**Supporting Documentation:** Copies of your ancestor's original service or pension records or Adjutant General records must accompany the application. Additional information about the applicant's Civil War ancestor, including but not limited to his affiliation with the Grand Army of the Republic (G.A.R.), or other post-Civil War veterans' organization(s), and his resting place may be attached as well. Computer or internet generated secondary reports are not acceptable.

**Lineage:** The applicant will provide his lineage from himself to his veteran ancestor. The last line should end with the name of the Civil War ancestor. Provide all information available concerning the lineage. Use "Not Known" or "Not Applicable", as appropriate, when the information is not known or does not apply.
